Entries: Entries will not be accepted without fees. Faxed, telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC entry form, and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. No refund for duplicate entries, errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. No entries will be accepted which require a signature for delivery.

Test Worker Option: Per Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Regulations, one TDX track will be set aside for test workers. In the event no TD or TDU entries are received then two TDX tracks will be set aside for test workers. Anyone who assisted at the test site on plotting day and/or on test day for any Cornhusker Kennel Club tracking test held in the current (2026) or previous (2025) calendar year will be eligible. If necessary, a random drawing may be held to determine which test workers are chosen. The remaining workers will automatically be included in the drawing with all other tracking entries received. The test secretary must be notified by the worker of their intent to be considered for a test worker track.

Entry Fees: TD – \$80.00 TDU - \$90.00 TDX- \$125.00 (includes \$0.50 AKC recording fee & \$4.00 event service fee) Make checks payable to: **Cornhusker Kennel Club**. No entry fee will be refunded except the entry fee for an alternate that does not participate. Those fees will be refunded within seven days following the test. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry.

Closing Date: Entries for this TD/TDU/TDX Test close Thursday, 6 PM, March 12, 2026 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Drawing of entries for TD/TDU/TDX Test: A drawing will be held at 7:30 PM, Thursday, March 12, 2026 at Burger King, 2045 S 17th St, Lincoln, NE to fill entry limits. The drawing shall be completely random among all entries received, and in accordance with provisions set forth in the Tracking Regulations Ch. 1, Sec 17. If the limit for entries is not reached in one test, and exceeded in the other, the number of tracks will be exchanged according to the limits set forth in Ch. 1 Sec. 17a. All entrants will be notified of the results of the draw by phone or email.

Upon notification, alternates shall have the option of accepting or refusing the opportunity to participate in the test. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, the first alternate entry present according to the order in which they were drawn, as set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall assume the vacant position.

Bitches in Season: Tracking Regulation Chapter 2, Section 8.

Bitches in season may participate. The Test Secretary and judges are to be notified prior to the drawing for running order that a bitch is in season. The last track(s) to be laid shall be reserved for the bitch(es) in season. If there is more than one bitch in season, a second draw for these bitches will be held.

Certification: With each entry form for a licensed or member Tracking DogTest or Tracking Dog Urban Test for a dog that has not passed an AKC Tracking Test, there must be filed an original written statement, dated within 24 months of the date of the Tracking Test, signed by either person approved to judge tracking tests, or by a person/evaluator who has handled a dog to a TDX or VST title within the last ten (10) years, and must certify that the dog has satisfactorily performed a certification test.

The CORNHUSKER KENNEL CLUB, the test secretary, tracking committee, etc. assumes no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, exhibitor's property, their dogs and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

The Cornhusker Kennel Club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

The club may cancel the event in extreme weather conditions.

W. Branched Oak Rd. to the Middle Oak Creek campground entrance (1.25 miles), turn right into the campground, the draw site will be near the entrance.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories or dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition; Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in the show's premium list. If the dog show class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
